July 26	Wednesday	Sunset Community Library	Zucchini Slaw	Word-search handouts	Zucchini Campaign word-search; Zucchini Campaign Tattoos (a sponge and water for application) as rewards for completing the word-search!	Summer Meal Site Manager	Keep it simple this week. Site managers should let kids know they are eating local zucchini and encourage them to try the slaw. Handout word-search and use stickers as incentives for them to complete them and hand them back in!





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
